HOSTS

The Nantucket Yacht Club (NYC), Great Harbor Yacht Club (GHYC), Nantucket Community Sailing (NCS), the Nantucket Race Week (NRW) Committee, and in conjunction with the Nantucket International One Design Fleet Association, Inc. (NIODFA).

Merchandise for NRW can be ordered and customized in advance at the website and will be available at both yacht clubs during NRW.

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, including Appendix V (Alternative Penalties), the International One Design Class World Association Constitution and By-laws, the Fleet Rules & Regulations of the Nantucket One Design Fleet Association (NIODFA) and NIODFA By-Laws.

1.2 NYC Policies and Protocols, as published on the official notice board will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The series is open to International One Design boats, owned by the NIODFA.

3.2 Skippers must be either members of the NIODFA or Approved Substitute Skippers, pursuant to the NIODFA By-Laws.

3.3 Boats entered in the NYC August Series are automatically entered in this regatta.

3.4 Eligible boats which are not registered for the NYC August Series may enter by completing the entry form online (click on the Sailing tab) and submitting the entry form, no later than **August 11 at 1115**.

3.5 Membership in US Sailing is encouraged.

4 FEES

4.1 There is no entry fee. A donation of \$25 to NCS would be appreciated.

4.2 Tickets for all NRW social events may be purchased online (click on the Overview/Social Events tab) or at the Regatta Desk located at the NYC. Space is limited. Please make reservations early.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI) will be the SI used in the NYC IOD Summer Series. They will be available at the NYC website by June 25, and linked from the NRW website by August 8. Copies will be available at the Regatta Desk located at the NYC, and at the competitors meeting.

6 SCHEDULE

1100	Competitors meeting, NYC
1230	First warning signal (<i>or earlier, if all participating boats check in as "ready to race"</i>)
1630	Awards Ceremony, NYC

7 VENUE

All races will be held on Nantucket Sound.

8 SCORING

- 8.1** Four races are scheduled.
- 8.2** One completed race constitutes a regatta.
- 8.3** A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

When flag Y is flown from the race committee signal boat prior to the warning signal, the Turns penalties of RRS V1 are replaced by the Scoring Penalty of RRS 44.3.

11 PRIZES

11.1 Prizes will be presented at the Awards Ceremony at the NYC after racing on

August 11.


11.2 The top-performing skipper in a one-design fleet will also receive a special NRW prize, to be presented Saturday, August 17 at the NYC.

12 DAMAGES

Damages for at-fault skippers will be limited to \$2000 per damaged boat, per incident. Responsibility for damage to one or more boats shall be borne by the team sailing the boat when the damage occurred, or by the team responsible for the damage in the judgment of the Organizing Authority; or if caused while racing, by the team deemed at fault for the incident, as determined by the Protest Committee. If no protest is filed because the at-fault boat retired or accepted a penalty pursuant to the rules, they shall be held responsible for any damage from an incident. If damage occurs as a result of an incident between boats, and neither boat delivers a protest, then the boats involved in the incident shall be held responsible equally.
