HOSTS

The Nantucket Yacht Club (NYC), Great Harbor Yacht Club (GHYC), Nantucket Community Sailing (NCS), and the Nantucket Race Week (NRW) Committee.

Merchandise for NRW can be ordered and customized in advance at the website and will be available at both yacht clubs during NRW.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, including Appendix V (Alternative Penalties).
- 1.2 NYC Policies and Protocols, and local Nantucket fleet rules as published on the official notice board will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the following classes: Alerion, Indian, Rhodes 19, Marshall Cat 15, Marshall Cat 18, the "12 ½" class, and Rainbows. Races may be held for other classes.
- 3.2 Boats registered for the NYC August Series are automatically entered in this regatta.
- 3.3 Eligible boats which are not registered for the NYC August Series may enter by completing the entry form online (click on the Sailing tab) and submitting the entry form, no later than Saturday, **August 10 at 1115.**
- 3.4 Membership in US Sailing is encouraged.

4 FEES

- 4.1 There is no entry fee. A donation to NCS of \$25 would be appreciated.
- 4.2 Tickets for all NRW social events may be purchased online (click on Overview/Social

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI) will be the SI used in the NYC One-Design Series. They will be available at the NYC website by June 25, and linked from the NRW website by August 8. Copies will be available at the Regatta Desk located at the NYC, and at the competitors meeting.

7 VENUE

- 7.1 The available racing areas inside Nantucket harbor will be shown in the sailing instructions.
- 7.2 Alerions, Indians, Rhodes-19s, and Marshall Cat-18s will race on **Race Circle One**, which will be either in Area 2 or Area 3. Marshall Cat-15s, "12 1/2s", Rainbows, and other invited classes will race on **Race Circle Two**, which will normally be in Area 1.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 Nine races are scheduled for classes on Circle One, and 15 races for classes on Circle Two.

- 8.2 One completed race constitutes a regatta.
- 8.3 When five or more races are completed, one worst score will be excluded, as permitted in RRS 90.3(b), from a boat's series score.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

When flag Y is flown from the race committee signal boat prior to the warning signal, the Turns penalties of RRS V1 are replaced by the Scoring Penalty of RRS 44.3 for all classes.

11 PRIZES

- 11.1 A minimum of three boats must compete in any class in order for awards to be given out in that class.
- 11.2 Daily awards will be presented at 1600 at the NYC after racing each day.
- 11.3 Overall awards will also be presented to the top three finishers in each class at the Awards Ceremony at the NYC after racing on Saturday, August 17.
- 11.4 The top-performing skipper in a one-design fleet will also receive a special NRW prize, to be presented Saturday, August 17 at the NYC.

12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with adequate and valid third-party liability insurance.
