M.R.A. FALL SERIES NOTICE OF RACE AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

September 2012

1. **Introduction:** All of the provisions (including amendments) of the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions for the **2012** Season of the Marblehead Racing Association (MRA) will apply except as otherwise stated in this document.
2. **Eligibility:** This series is open to any boat registered with MRA for the **2012** season.
3. **Notices to Competitors:** Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the hallway near the trophy room of CYC.
4. **Schedule and Racing Area:** All classes will race in the **Midway** Line area or closer to MRA Mark 18, Marblehead Channel Bell. The first Warning signal will be no earlier than **12:00** EDT. One race will constitute a series.
5. Dates and high tides (EDT) are as follows:

Sat., Sept. 8	Fall #1	17:36
Sat., Sept. 15	Fall #2	11:11
Sat., Sept. 22	Fall #3	16:55
6. **Signals Made Ashore:** Signals (as defined by MRA #5) will be displayed from the yardarm of CYC only.
7. **Courses and Marks:** Courses will be as provided by MRA for **Midway** Line. Marks will normally be ORANGE tetrahedrons, EXCEPT that GREEN tetrahedrons will be used when MRA #10.3, #10.6, or #10.7 applies.
8. **Radio Communication:** VHF Channel 78 will be used for recalls (MRA #13), emergency reports from contestants (MRA #21.1) and courtesy broadcasts (MRA #21.2).
9. **Time Limit:** The 2½-hour time limit and the 30-minute finishing window (MRA #15) will apply to all classes.
10. **Protests:** As in MRA #17 but with all filings and hearings at CYC .
11. **Prizes:** Day prizes will be given in accordance with MRA #22 on each day. First prize for the series will be awarded to the winner in each class; additional series prizes will be awarded, depending on the average number of starters for all races completed.
